

Did You Know?

Each month, of the 157,000+ people who visited the Spruce Grove Library last year, an average of \$410 per family and \$103 per individual was saved on their monthly entertainment costs—and library card holders saved even more!

The 20,700+ people used library computers saved an average of \$360 each on personal internet expenses in 2016; collectively, that's a savings of \$51,663.75 per month.

By borrowing instead of purchasing, book lovers save an average of \$3627.98 per year using their Spruce Grove Public Library card.

Movie enthusiasts save a yearly average of \$2707.22 using their Spruce Grove Public Library card to borrow rather than by DVDs.

Families save an additional average of \$1627.21 borrowing literacy backpacks, magazines, sensory backpacks, CDs, bibliotherapy kits, TransAlta Tri Leisure Centre passes, and more.
