



Use of the Library by Children

Parents or legal guardians must assume responsibility for deciding what library resources are appropriate for their children. Access to library resources is not limited to "age appropriate" material, and includes print, audiovisual and unfiltered internet access. The library's staff is not in a position to provide this monitoring and supervision or to serve in loco parentis.

Children under the age of twelve must be accompanied by a parent or caregiver in the library. Children left unaccompanied in the library in violation of the policy may necessitate a referral to Children Services or other authorities.

Children twelve and older may be unaccompanied provided they observe proper conduct. Such children are subject to the same rules of conduct as other patrons and to the same consequences, including being asked to leave the library if warranted.

Children of any age who require special supervision must be accompanied by a parent or responsible caregiver at all times.
